

FREE Community Sharps Disposal Service

Finger Lakes Health offers free, convenient drop-off services for sharp medical waste, such as needles, syringes and lancets. Household sharps must be properly contained and discarded to protect trash handlers and waste treatment workers against disease or injury.

Containers must be sealed and made of puncture-resistant hard plastic, such as detergent or bleach bottles. Flimsy plastic containers, metal cans, glass bottles and cardboard containers will not be accepted. Containers must be properly labeled "Contains Sharps."
